We also have Kerry who is helping voluntarily at the moment alongside her normal role as a fully qualified and experienced youth worker.



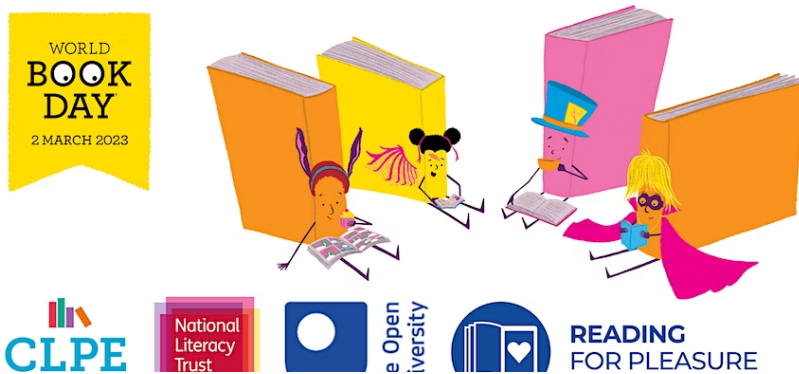
A polite remind that our fees will be increasing from March as mentioned in the previous newsletter.
